■ FIFTY WASHINGTON and Lee ROTC students will receive reserve commissions at 9 a.m. on graduation day, June 6.

An additional eleven students will be awarded commissions during the summer, after they complete the necessary six weeks of ROTC camp.

For Colonel Charles E. Coates, Jr., professor of military science and tactics, the commissioning ceremony on June 6 will be his fourth at Washington and Lee, and his last official duty for the corps. He is being transferred to Germany in July. Only one officer of the present staff will remain, with replacements for others scheduled to come in during the summer.
