WASHINGTON AND LEE.

Football Eleven the Best the University Has Had in Many Years.

The Washington and Lee University team, which plays George Washington University team Thanksgiving, is, with exception of the University of Virginia team and the Virginia Polytechnic In-stitute, undoubtedly the fastest team in Virginia. So far this year it has scored 154 points to opponents 36, and has lost but two games out of nine played. The powerful Virginia Palytechnic Institute team scored but two touchdowns and a field goal against her, while the equally heavy North Carolina team scored twenty-one. Virginia Polytechnic Institute and North Carolina each weighed 180, while the Washington and Lee team averages 155. Washington and Lee is coached by Brown, a Dartmouth half back on the 1901 team, which scored 12 points against Harvard the week previous to the game in which Harvard shut Yale out, 22 to 0. Brown turned out two teams at Virginia Polytechnic Institute which defeated Georgetown 32-6 and 28-0, and the Navy 11-0. Last year he was at the University of North Carolina, and was successful there. His team at Washington and Lee is the best that university has had in years, though it is the lightest.
